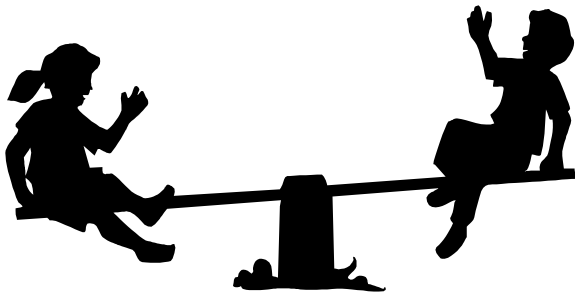

Transportation

Sibling Discount— 15% off tuition for each additional child

In addition a non-refundable \$35.00 per child annual registration fee must be paid upon enrollment.

Last Week Deposit- A deposit equivalent to 1 week of tuition must be paid along with your first month's tuition. The deposit will be applied to your child's last week with the Fun Club.

Methods of Payment— Payments may be made in check, Visa/MC, or day care voucher. All upfront paperwork must be completed before attending the program.
